

Scale of Fees & Charges from September 2022



FEES PER TERM

Pre-Prep

Nursery* (3-4 years) to 1.10 pm with lunch (Michaelmas/Lent only)£2,398

Nursery* (3-4 years) full days with lunch £3,206

Reception* (4-5 years) full days with lunch£3,821

Years 1 & 2 (5-7 years) full days with lunch £4,019

Pre-Prep fees include lunch and school from 8.00 am to 3.30 pm.

Prep

Year 3 (7-8 years) £4,680

Year 4 (8-9 years) £4,809

Years 5 and 6 (9-11 years) £4,847

Prep fees include lunch and school from 8.00 am to 5.45 pm.

(The School reserves the right to charge a late fee of £15 to parents of Prep children, each time they are collected after 5.45pm. This is to cover additional staff costs.)

School-approved childcare vouchers can be used to pay for fees up to Age 5.*

Family Discount

A 5% discount is offered to a second sibling, and 10% is offered to third and subsequent siblings **whilst simultaneously attending the school** with the exception that there is no discount on part-time Nursery places (attendance to 1.10 pm).

After Care * (Nursery/Pre-Prep)

After Care runs from 3.30 pm to 5.45 pm Monday to Friday with sessions at 3.30 pm, 4.15 pm and 5.00 pm.

1 day, same session for the term £60

5 days, same session for the term £297

Ad hoc bookings £15.00 per session

Breakfast Club (Years 2 to 6)

7.30 to 8.00 am.....£3:00 per day

Our Breakfast Club provision will be reintroduced as soon as our Risk Assessment permits us to do so.

School-approved childcare vouchers can be used to pay for those activities marked *.

Additional Information

The School requires a full term's notice in writing of a parent's intention to remove a child. This must be received by the Headmaster on, or before, the first day of the term at the end of which the child is to leave. Failure to provide such notice will result in a full term's fees being charged in lieu of notice.

The fees quoted in the table opposite include lunches and morning snacks and, for children in Prep, afternoon snacks. For all pupils the fees include tuition according to the standard timetable; the provision of most educational materials and textbooks; use of computers and scientific equipment, as appropriate; curricular swimming lessons for Years 1 to 6; and the provision of most games equipment.

The School participates in the Early Years Funding Scheme for 3 and 4 year olds up to a maximum of 15 hours per week.

Registering a child
